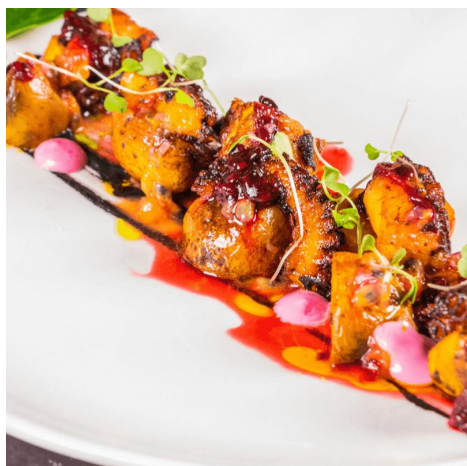
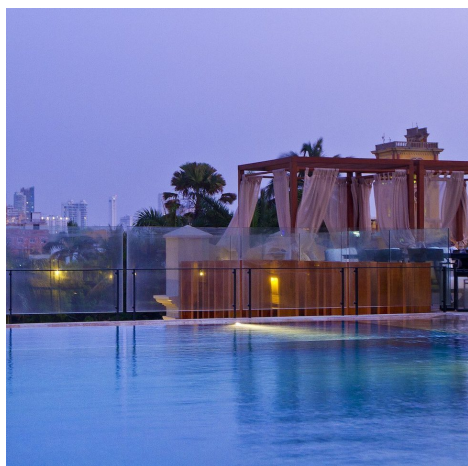

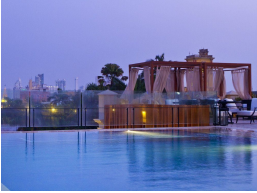

Day 1



¡Bienvenidos—Cartagena Is Calling!

¡Bienvenidos! Touch down at Rafael Núñez International Airport, where your meet-and-greet is waiting — look for a sign with your name or Caviar in the Air. Your transfer takes you to the Sofitel Legend Santa Clara, a 17th-century convent turned luxury sanctuary in the heart of the walled city, with check-in from 3 PM. Settle in, then head up to the rooftop at six for sunset cocktails. Tonight's welcome dinner is a chef's tasting menu built on the best local products, served in a dining room with 400 years of history. The magic has officially begun.

Day 2



Seaside Sanctuary—A Private Island Day

Breakfast at the hotel, then a boat out to a private-island beach club just off Cartagena: white-and-blue design, tropical greenery, and music drifting over the water. Claim a lounge by the pool or on the sand and alternate warm swims with cold drinks while the staff keeps the towels coming. Midday is a long, unhurried lunch — bright ceviches, seafood, crisp salads — and by late afternoon the light goes gold and the music lifts before the boat ride back. The evening is yours: the Walled City starts at the hotel's door, so wander the plazas, find a rooftop for a drink, and choose your own table for dinner.

Day 3

Discovering Getsemaní—The City, Properly Introduced

A private city tour with hotel pickup, paced so you get oriented without ever feeling rushed. Start at San Felipe de Barajas Castle, walking the fortress while your guide fills in the conquest, the pirates and the layered history that shaped Colombia's Caribbean coast. Then into the Walled City — colonial streets, Santo Domingo Square, the Cathedral — and on to Getsemaní, where street art and music give the old town a modern pulse. You taste as you go: coconut sweets, arepa con huevo, the everyday flavours locals actually eat. The afternoon is free, and we would point you toward the Gold Museum or the Spanish Inquisition Museum. Dinner tonight is yours to choose.

Day 4



Night Out in Cartagena

The day is open. If you want it, there is an optional afternoon run out to the Totumo Mud Volcano — a slippery staircase up a small hill, then a float in warm mineral mud (email us to book; it carries an extra cost). Either way the evening is ours. Cartagena is at its best after dark, and this private walk begins at Plaza de la Aduana and moves through the Old Town's colonial squares while a local guide hands you the legends and the anecdotes daytime tours skip. Then a typical Caribbean coastal dinner — fried fish with coconut rice and patacones, posta cartagenera, a seafood casserole — and a spread of artisanal Colombian sweets to finish.

Day 5



Palenque—Walking Sacred Ground

Today we journey to sacred ground. Palenque is the first free African town in the Americas—a community of resistance and resilience that has preserved its language, music, and traditions for centuries. Walk streets where freedom was won, not given. Share a traditional lunch with locals who welcome you like family, and taste Afro-Colombian flavors passed down through generations. This experience connects you to a story bigger than any single trip.

Day 6



Shopping & Farewell Feast

Final full day in Cartagena means one more chance to fall deeper in love. Shop for souvenirs in the walled city—hand-woven mochilas and Colombian emeralds make excellent companions. Visit a museum, or simply exist poolside letting it all sink in. Tonight's farewell dinner is legendary—innovative Colombian cuisine in an intimate atmosphere that celebrates everything this country does best. Bring your appetite and your gratitude.

One final breakfast at the Sofitel Legend Santa Clara, one final moment in this magical city. 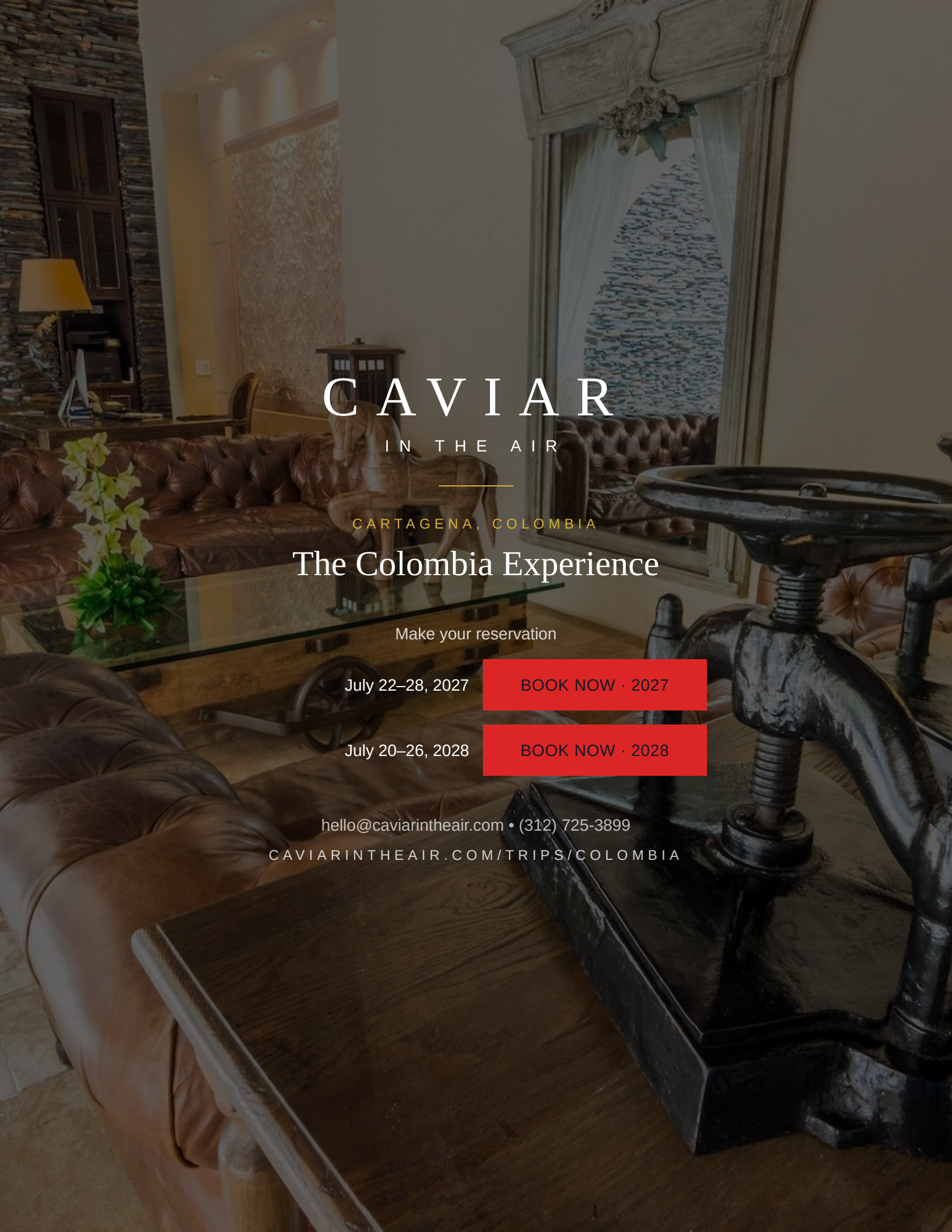
