Your 8-Day Journey

Day 1



Split, Then Straight Out to Sea

Land at Split (SPU) — mornings are best — and look for the sign with your name on it. The group rolls to Marina Baotic just after midday, and by half past one you are checking into your ensuite cabin on a private mega yacht that is entirely ours. Lunch is served the moment we pull away, because we are not wasting an afternoon: it is a three-hour sail to Bol on the island of Brač. Somewhere in there, the welcome reception and safety briefing — the cocktail-in-hand, gourmet-spread kind of safety briefing. Dinner tonight is yours to choose in Bol: a waterfront table, or a garden one in the olive groves near the beach. Then back to the top deck, lit up and open late.

Day 2

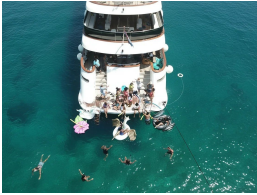


Korčula: Old Stone, Then Open Throttle

Breakfast buffet from eight, and we cast off at nine for Korčula, the most medieval town on this coast. The old town is laid out like a fishbone, every side street angled to catch the breeze and break the wind, which is the sort of thing people worked out long before air conditioning. A guided walk at three pulls the history out of the stone. At half five you trade the cobbles for a buggy and run the island's backroads in convoy, ending with a toast, local snacks and something cold in your hand. Dinner is on your own and the tables are held for quarter past nine or later, which is the correct hour to eat in Dalmatia anyway.

Day 3



A Swim Stop, Then the Pearl at Dusk

Cast off at nine and sail into open water with nowhere in particular to be. By noon the engines cut and the Adriatic goes that impossible clear green. This is the swim stop, and it is the whole argument for chartering a yacht instead of booking hotels: snorkel, float, climb the ladder, do it again. At three we set a course for Dubrovnik, and the evening sail in is the best arrival in the Mediterranean and it is not close. The coastline goes to silhouette, the light goes amber, and everyone stops talking. Dinner in Dubrovnik is on your own tonight, and the Old Town after dark is worth walking hungry for.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 4



Dubrovnik, Walls and Westeros

Coach into the Old Town just before ten for a guided tour through all that marble and limestone: the walls, the Stradun, the history, and the improbable story of how the place survived. Lunch is your call, a table in town or back aboard. The afternoon has an optional Game of Thrones filming-locations tour, two hours of standing exactly where the scenes were shot. Dinner is on your own again, and then, if you want it, there is a club built inside the city's medieval fortress walls that runs until it does not. Both answers are correct.

Day 5



Trstenik and a Village Table

A slow morning in Dubrovnik, then we cast off at two for the Peljesac peninsula, Croatia's great red wine country, which tumbles straight into the sea. We anchor at Trstenik by five, and half an hour later you are sitting down to the village dinner people come back for: traditional dishes cooked the old way, ingredients sourced from within sight of the table, and a rustic setting no restaurant could fake. This is the meal that is still in the group chat two years later.

Day 6

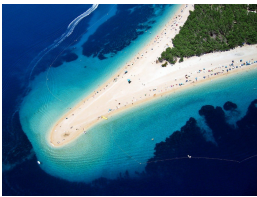


Hvar in All White

An early cast-off at half seven and a long, gorgeous sail north to the most glamorous harbour on the Adriatic. We are in by three, which gives you exactly enough time to get into the all-white you packed for tonight. A walking tour at half four covers Hvar's history and its heritage, then at half six we head to a seafront beach bar for sunset — everyone in white, the light doing precisely what you hoped it would. Dinner is on your own. And around midnight, boats leave the dock for an island club just offshore. Bring cash for the ride out and back, and do not make any promises about what time you will be home.

Day 7



Bol, the Golden Horn and the Captain's Dinner

Cast off at half seven, docked in Bol by nine, with the prettiest town on Brac laid out in front of you: stone houses, a waterfront promenade, gelato, shops, and the little train that runs down to the beach. Zlatni Rat, the Golden Horn, is a blade of white pebbles that curls into turquoise and shifts its point with the current, so it is never quite the same shape twice. Back aboard at half twelve for a wine tasting in the dining room, then lunch. The afternoon is yours entirely. At seven, the farewell Captain's Dinner in Bol — dress up, this is the evening the whole week has been quietly building toward — and at eight we sail back to Marina Baotic with the sun going down behind us.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8



No Goodbyes, Just See You Soon

One last breakfast on deck, cabins checked out by nine, and your transfer to Split airport for flights out any time after midday. You came for a boat and you are leaving with a group chat. If you find yourself planning the return before you land, you are in very good company.
