Day 1



Touch Down in Egypt—Your Pharaoh Era Begins!

Welcome to the land of the Nile. You crossed an ocean to get here, so the first thing we do is put you somewhere worthy: the Four Seasons Nile Plaza, with the river moving right outside your window. Look for your name at arrivals, message the concierge the second you land, and let us handle everything after that. Tonight we gather at a Nile-side table for a long Mediterranean welcome dinner—casual, loud, exactly right.

Day 2



King Tut's Treasures & the Bazaar After Dark

Tahrir Square, morning light, and five thousand years waiting inside. Your private Egyptologist walks you through the Egyptian Museum to Tutankhamun's golden mask and the royal jewelry that still stops grown people mid-sentence. The middle of the day is yours—or add the optional Grand Egyptian Museum tour out at Giza, where Tut's full collection sits together for the first time since it was dug up. Come evening we walk Al-Muizz Street, a kilometer of medieval Cairo lit gold, into the alleyways of Khan el-Khalili for a multi-course Egyptian dinner at a bazaar institution that has been feeding travelers for decades. Haggle hard.

Day 3



The Pyramids & Sphinx—Bucket List Activated

This is THE moment. One of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World standing in front of you, 4,500 years deep. Your Egyptologist gives you the Giza plateau properly—the Great Pyramid, the causeways, and the Sphinx guarding secrets nobody has cracked yet. If you want to go inside the small pyramid, you can, on your own ticket at the gate. Lunch is a long one nearby with real Egyptian cooking. One honest note: we no longer arrange camel rides at Giza. The welfare standards there are not where they need to be, and we would rather tell you the truth than sell you the photo. Dinner tonight is yours—Cairo has opinions.

Day 4



Luxor Bound—Karnak, Cruise Mode, Cocktails

Cairo's noise traded for the river's quiet. A short morning flight drops you into Luxor, and by lunchtime you are aboard Sun Boat IV, your riverboat—forty guests, Art Deco cabins, a pool on the sun deck, and four nights of Egypt sliding past the window. Lunch is served the moment you are settled. Then straight into the deep end: Karnak, the largest religious complex ever built, a thousand years of pharaohs trying to outdo each other, and Luxor Temple with its obelisks and preserved statues. Afternoon tea, a welcome dinner with your crew, and a belly dancing performance in the lounge to close it out.

Day 5

The West Bank—Kings, Queens & a Woman Who Ruled

West Bank day, and it is the big one. Optional sunrise hot air balloon first if you booked it—floating over the Theban necropolis as the light comes up is genuinely hard to put into words. Then the Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens, where the painted walls still hold their color; the Temple of Hatshepsut rising in terraces at Deir el-Bahari, built for the woman who ruled as pharaoh and made everyone deal with it; and the Colossi of Memnon, standing guard for 3,400 years. Tutankhamun's own tomb is a separate ticket if you want it. Back aboard for lunch, then we sail to Esna, take tea on deck, and raise a glass at the Captain's Welcome Cocktail before dinner and a film under the stars.

Day 6



Edfu, Kom Ombo & the Galabia Party

Breakfast on the water hits different. We sail into Edfu and spend the morning inside the Temple of Horus—the best-preserved temple in Egypt, dedicated to the falcon god, with reliefs so crisp you can practically read the rituals off the walls. Lunch as we sail on to Kom Ombo, tea in the afternoon, then the temple at Kom Ombo in the evening: a rare double, split straight down the middle between Sobek the crocodile god and Horus the elder. Tonight is the Galabia party. Traditional dress, Egyptian music, and a dance floor that does not quit.

Day 7



Aswan—Philae, the Dam & a Nubian Night

Aswan by sunrise. The High Dam first—1960s engineering that tamed the Nile's flood and still powers the country—then Philae Temple on the island of Agilkia, lifted stone by stone to save it from the rising water, dedicated to Isis, and easily the most romantic place we will stand all week. Lunch aboard, then a motorboat out onto the Nile and time in the botanical garden. Tea on deck, dinner, and a Nubian show to finish: drums, color, and a culture that has held its own for thousands of years.

Day 8



Off the Boat, Back to Cairo

Last breakfast on the water, then we disembark and say goodbye to the crew who have spent four days learning how you take your coffee. Your tour leader takes you to Aswan Airport for the short flight back to Cairo, and from the terminal it is a walk—no transfer, no traffic—to Le Meridien Cairo Airport for the night. The afternoon is entirely yours. Sleep, swim, repack, or sit still and let the week finally land.

Day 9



No Goodbyes, Just See You Soon!

Breakfast, check out, and a short walk back to the terminal—three hours ahead of your flight, because we do not do frantic. You are leaving different than you arrived. You have stood in the Valley of the Kings, sailed the Nile from Luxor to Aswan, and touched stone that was already ancient before Rome existed. The friendships stay. The glow is permanent. No goodbyes—just see you soon.
