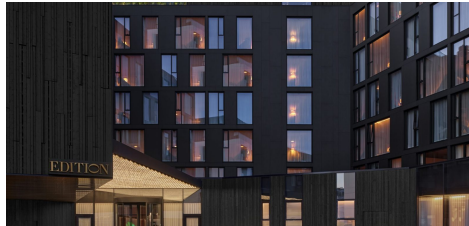
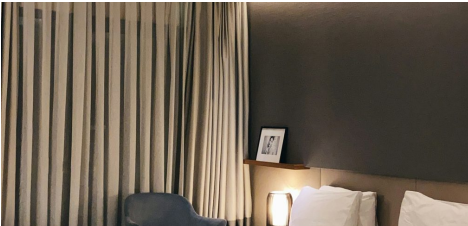

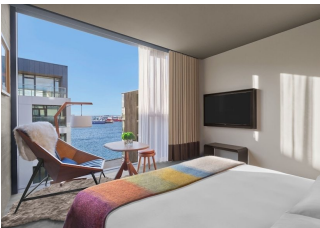

Your 7-Day Journey

Day 1



Welcome to the Land of Fire & Ice!

Land at Keflavik before 3 PM and join the group for a private transfer into Reykjavik. Check in at The Reykjavik EDITION from 3 PM and take the rest of the afternoon at your own pace. At seven the group sits down to the welcome dinner at a Michelin Guide restaurant in the city: a four-course chef's tasting menu with wine pairing and gratuity, reserved under Caviar in the Air. Business casual for the evening.

Day 2



Golden Circle—Nature's Greatest Hits

Breakfast at the hotel, then a nine o'clock pickup and a guided drive into the countryside. Walk between two continents at Almannagjá gorge in Þingvellir National Park, where Iceland's first parliament met in 930 AD. Watch Strokkur erupt every few minutes at the Geysir geothermal area, then feel the spray off Gullfoss as it drops in two tiers into the canyon. Lunch is in a geothermal tomato greenhouse—soup, warm bread and a main, grown metres from the table. A scenic drive back, with a stop for Icelandic horses, has you in Reykjavik by 6:30.

Day 3

Free Day, Then the Aurora

The day is yours: the hotel spa, the city, or one of the two optional peninsula tours. The night is the one you came for. A nine o'clock pickup, a minibus capped at eighteen, and a drive out to whichever dark-sky spot the forecast favours that evening. Warm jumpsuits, chairs, hot cocoa, Icelandic snacks, and a guide who photographs you under the lights on a proper camera. Back at the hotel by one. Aurora nights are chosen on one to two days' notice from the forecast, so keep your evenings flexible—and if the sky closes in, you go out again on another night at no charge.

Day 4



South Coast Waterfalls & Glacier Hike

An eight o'clock departure for the South Coast. Walk behind the curtain at Seljalandsfoss, then take the short wade into the canyon to find Gljúfrabúi, the one most people drive past. Skógafoss next: sixty metres of water, and 527 steps to the platform above it. Then Sólheimajökull, where your guide fits crampons, helmet, harness and ice axe for a three-hour hike across the ice, over ridges and past crevasses. The day closes at Reynisfjara, with its black sand, the Reynisdrangar sea stacks offshore and the basalt geometry of Hálsanefshellir cave. Back in Reykjavik by evening. Bring boots, waterproofs and something to eat—lunch is on your own today.

Day 5



Free Day in Reykjavik

Nothing scheduled after breakfast. Climb the tower at Hallgrímskirkja for the view over the coloured rooftops, walk the Old Harbour, shop Laugavegur, or give an afternoon to the National Museum or the glass architecture of Harpa. Almost everything is walkable from the hotel. Or stay in it entirely—the spa, the fitness floor and the rooftop bar are all yours. The concierge is on chat from 1 to 5 PM if you want a reservation made.

Day 6



Blue Lagoon & the Farewell Table

A slow morning, then a one o'clock pickup out through the lava fields to the Blue Lagoon for three hours in the milky blue water. The Signature Experience is included: three face masks from the in-water mask bar, two drinks, a bathrobe for the visit and skincare to take home. Bring a swimsuit, and condition your hair before you get in. Back at the hotel by six, and at eight the group sits down to the farewell dinner at a refined downtown restaurant known for modern Nordic cooking—served family style with wine to share. Smart casual to elegant.

Day 7



Bless Bless, Iceland!

Icelanders say 'Bless bless' when parting—a double blessing for the road ahead. A last breakfast at the hotel, then your private Caviar in the Air driver takes you out to Keflavik. Book anything departing after 8 AM. The Northern Lights may have danced for you, or they may have played hard to get—either way, this otherworldly island has left its mark.
