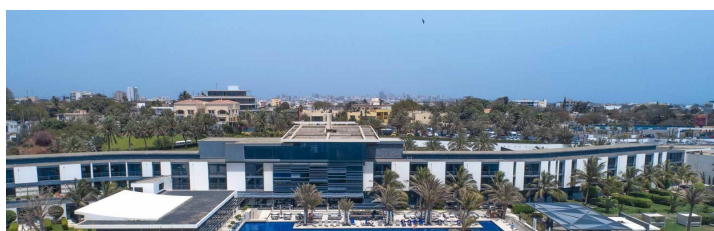

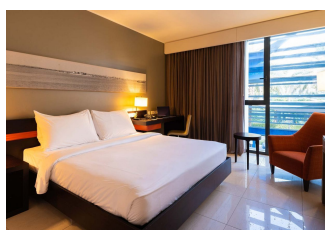

Your 8-Day Journey

Day 1



Welcome to Senegal

You should land at Blaise Diagne (DSS) before 3 PM, where a driver is waiting with your name on a sign. Check in at the Noom Blu Hotel, drop your bags, and let the Atlantic do its work for a couple of hours. At seven the group heads out for the welcome dinner at a Dakar restaurant, where you choose your own appetizer, entree and dessert, with bottled water and two glasses of local wine poured alongside. Casual attire. This is where the week starts and where the strangers stop being strangers.

Meals: Welcome Dinner

Day 2

Exploring Dakar

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, then the ferry out to Goree Island. A UNESCO World Heritage Site and the departure point of the transatlantic slave trade, Goree is not a light morning and it is not meant to be. Back on the mainland, lunch at the Noom Blu, then a private tour through the Medina Market for local artwork and whatever else finds you. Evening is yours.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3



Dakar Cultural Experience

Morning at the Great Mosque of Massalikoul Djinane, then the Museum of Black Civilization. Fourteen thousand square meters opened in 2018, holding artifacts and exhibits that trace African civilizations from ancient times to now. Lunch at a local family-run restaurant for authentic Senegalese cooking, then the African Renaissance Monument in the afternoon, over 160 feet of it — a man, a woman and a child with their arms out to the Atlantic. Dress conservatively for the mosque; coverage is available there if you need it.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4



Safari Adventure and the Pink Lake

An early breakfast, then an hour out to the Bandia Reserve for a safari through giraffes, zebras, rhinos and whatever else the morning turns up. Three-course lunch with wine at the restaurant inside the reserve. In the afternoon, Lac Rose, the Pink Lake, where salt and algae turn the water rose and a 4x4 takes you along the shoreline. Wear all white here if you want the photographs everyone comes back with.

Day 5



Free Day in Dakar

Nothing scheduled. Sleep in, swim, book the spa, or go back to whichever part of Dakar you did not finish. The concierge can hold a table or a treatment for you on the Q&A chat, and the day belongs to you.

Day 6



Saly and Shell Island

Check out after breakfast and drive south to Saly. On the way, Joal-Fadiouth, the shell island, where the ground is built from centuries of shells and Christian and Muslim traditions share the same small streets. Lunch at a seaside resort restaurant in Saly, fresh seafood and a view. Then check in at the Movenpick Lamantin Beach, where the pool, the sand and the rest of the week are waiting. Dinner at the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7



Sunset Beach Dinner

Breakfast on the beach, then the day is yours at the Lamantin. The infinity pool over the Atlantic, the spa, the private beach, kayaks and paddleboards, tennis, or the bar. Book treatments ahead. At seven the group comes back together for the farewell dinner by the sea, which is the one everybody remembers.

Meals: Breakfast, Farewell Dinner

Day 8



Say Goodbye to Senegal

A last breakfast at the Lamantin, then time on the Petite Cote for a swim or the last of the souvenir shopping before your private transfer to the airport. Depart any time after 8 AM from DSS. Keep your documents handy, and we will see you on the next one.
