Day 1



Sawadee Ka—Welcome to the Land of Smiles!

Sawadee ka! Touch down in the Land of Smiles where ancient tradition meets electric modernity. A driver meets you in arrivals holding your name, and you are off to Rosewood Bangkok in the heart of the business district, checking in from 3 PM. At 7:30 we gather downstairs for the welcome dinner: a multi-course Thai menu with paired wines and bubbles, covered by a \$100 per person credit that is yours to spend at the hotel if anything is left over. The adventure begins.

Day 2

Golden Palace Glow—Royalty Recognizes Royalty

Mornings belong to the temples. Start at Wat Pho, where a 46-metre reclining Buddha in gold leaf runs the length of the hall and the courtyards smell of incense, then move on to the Grand Palace and the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, Thailand's spiritual heart, dripping in gold and centuries of royal history. Dress appropriately (shoulders and knees covered) because royalty recognizes royalty. The afternoon is hands-on: a Thai cooking class where you learn to balance sweet, sour, salty and spicy. Dinner is your own, or join us for an optional group dinner.

Day 3



Ayutthaya—Ruins of a Lost Capital

A private car carries you north to Ayutthaya, the former capital of Siam, for the day. Stand before the Buddha head cradled in banyan roots at Wat Phra Mahathat, climb into the crypt at Wat Ratchaburana to see murals that have outlasted the centuries, wander a local market, and finish at Wat Chaiwatthanaram, where the prang and its chedis mirror themselves in the Chao Phraya River. Your guide works as your photographer all day. Back in Bangkok by early evening, with dinner at the hotel or on your own.

Bangkok, On Your Terms

Today is yours. Shop the malls and boutiques, wander the markets, book a treatment, or do nothing at all in one of Bangkok's best hotels. If you would rather be out, two optional tours run at \$175 per person: a full day at the Damnoen Saduak Floating Market and the Maeklong Railway Market, with Wat Bang Kung, the Wat Samphran Dragon Temple and lunch included; or an evening after-dark tour taking in Wat Saket, the Asiatique night market, Wat Arun lit up, a tuk-tuk run down Khaosan Road and a Michelin-starred dinner. Day 5

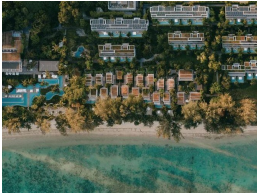


Phuket Bound—Beach Mode Fully Activated

Breakfast, then check out and transfer to Bangkok airport for the midday flight south. By early afternoon you are checking into Rosewood Phuket on Emerald Bay, where pavilions and villas come with private pools and the Andaman Sea starts about where the lawn ends. The rest of the day is free: walk the beach, swim, or do not move at all. Dinner is on your own, or join us for an optional group dinner.

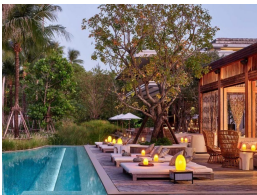


Phi Phi Islands—Paradise Found

A private speedboat takes the group out into the Andaman Sea for the day: Maya Bay, Pileh Lagoon walled in by limestone cliffs, Monkey Beach, Nui Beach, Camel Rock, Wang Long Beach and Phi Phi Don, the largest of the islands. Snorkel over the reefs, where sea turtles are regulars, and come up somewhere that looks retouched and is not. Back in Phuket by late afternoon. Dinner is on your own, or join us for an optional group dinner.

Your Day & Farewell Celebration

A full day at Rosewood Phuket with nothing on the schedule: the infinity pools, your own villa pool, the spa, the gardens, the beach. The resort will arrange whatever you would like, from yoga over the Andaman to a treatment or a class. If you would rather see the island, an optional full-day Phuket photo tour runs at \$175 per person, taking in the Big Buddha, Wat Chalong, Old Phuket Town and Karon View Point with lunch included. In the evening we gather for the farewell dinner: Southern Thai cooking, outdoors by the sea, one last night together.

One last breakfast at the resort and a noon check-out, then your private transfer, arranged by the hotel, takes you to Phuket International Airport for the journey home or onwards to whatever is next.
